League Rules:

1. League will consist of 8 teams made up of 3 bowlers per team.
2. N/A
3. This will be a handicapped league. Sweeps bowling will be handicapped.
4. The handicap basis will be 100% of 200 with no maximum handicap per bowler. BOWLERS WILL ESTABLISH THE FIRST WEEK OF LEAGUE TO DETERMINE HANDICAP.
5. The league will bowl the 4 point system with 3 games actually bowled. 1 point will be awarded for a team victory and 1 point for total team series.
6. League fees will be \$16.00 per bowler per week. Bowlers present must pay. Shortage allowed for an absent bowler but must be paid upon return. NO PAY.... NO PLAY! Teams using a sub for NAB must pay \$11.50 lineage. Teams with vacancy spot must pay prize fund (4.50) per NAB per week until filled. \$1.00 per bowler per week to sweepstakes doubles.
7. N/A
8. 1 paying members of a team must be present by the end of the FIRST frame to constitute a minimum legal line-up.
9. For an absent bowler on FIRST DAY/NIGHT team can use a sub or the following:
Set score of 150 plus 50 handicap minus 10.
10. For an absent bowler who has bowled at least 3 games, use sub or the following:
(1) Absent bowler's current sheet average minus 10 pins.
Bowlers average minus 10 pins cannot be used for more than 3 consecutive weeks. After 3 weeks, revert to rule 9.
11. N/A
12. SUBSTITUTE BOWLERS: New subs enter the league using rule 4.
13. Late bowlers may catch up before the completion of the 3rd frame of any game.
14. NO NEW MEMBERS OR NEW SUBS THE LAST WEEK OF THIS LEAGUE.
15. Handicap applied to individual awards after 6 games bowled. Eligibility to receive an individual award is at least 2/3rds games bowled in this league.
16. All ties will be decided by season total pins. If still tied team captains will decide a format to break the tie.
17. POSTPONEMENTS:
(1) EMERGENCY: (As defined by league officers and team captains) Team must notify either an opposing team captain, a league officer, or GABLE HOUSE BOWL.
(2) PLANNED: Team must notify opposing team captain or league secretary at least 48 hours IN ADVANCE PRIOR TO BOWLING.
(3) Teams may bowl unopposed. Scores not revealed until both teams have bowled. Pre-bowled games will not affect averages and handicaps until computed. ALL MAKE-UP GAMES SHOULD BE BOWLED WITHIN TWO WEEKS OR PRIOR TO THE NEXT POSITION WEEK, WHICHEVER IS SOONER. NO FORFEITS FOR UNOPPOSED BOWLING - TEAMS MUST BEAT THEIR OWN TEAM AVERAGE MINUS 10 PINS PER BOWLER, PLUS HANDICAP.
18. Team captains:
(1) Check in subs to league secretary prior to bowling.
(2) Payment of league fees to bowling desk prior to the 2nd game.
(3) Signature on recap sheet verifying all scores to be correct.
(4) To be aware that team is in good standing with rules and league fees.

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19. SWEEPSTAKES BOWLING: Schedule day March 26, 2015 the following will apply:
- (1) DRAW for lanes one week prior to bowling or teams placed by position.
 - (2) GUARANTEED SWEEPS: Fees of \$16.00 per bowler will be deducted from prize fund.
 - (3) ELIGIBILITY: Paid regular member with 15 or more games bowled.
 - (4) EVENTS: Doubles.
 - (5) GUARANTEED DOUBLES will be \$1.00 per bowler per week for 8 weeks.
 - (6) Payoffs for singles will be: NO
 - (7) Payoffs for doubles will be: 1 for every 8 entries. Mixed, men, and women.
 - (8) Payoffs for team event will be: \$36.00 for best team on sweeps.
 - (9) \$3.00 per bowler will be deducted from prize fund for Accu sweeps service.
20. BOWLER RESIGNING:
- Bowler must give a paid two week notice in writing to league secretary. Bowler must also pay all back shortages. Bowler forfeits any individual award and prize fund. Failure to do the above could result in suspension from GABLE HOUSE leagues and events.
21. GABLE HOUSE BOWL POLICIES:
- Defacing, breaking, or damaging any GABLE HOUSE property or equipment will be subject to: Suspension from GABLE HOUSE and/or repairs or replacement costs billed to the individual.
22. THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS: (LEAGUE OFFICERS AND TEAM CAPTAINS) will have one vote each and shall act on all matters disputed or not covered by these rules.
23. Rule changes need a 100% vote to change a league rule covered above. To adopt a new rule, all that is needed is a MAJORITY vote.

25. No children are allowed in the bowling (lower) area during league play.
26. ALL RULES ARE SUBJECT TO GABLE HOUSE APPROVAL.
